


# CS-Cart Add-on "Sliding Wrappers"

### 1. Purpose

Standard block wrappers are intended to wrap content and display title. The add-on adds two new interactive wrappers for blocks. Both bring more life into your site.



The first one is manual sliding wrapper, which acts by click and slides up or down block content, depending on the previous state. It is useful when you want displays additional information in dropdown block style.

The second one is automatic sliding wrapper and it allows setting up automatic disappearance or appearance of the block over time. You may create whole scenario by combining several blocks appearance / disappearance over time.

#### 2. Features

- Integrate two block wrappers into block manager: manual sliding wrappers and automatic sliding wrapper
- Manual sliding wrapper keeps its last state (collapsed /expanded) at Cookies.
- Automatic sliding wrapper have two timers: one for the action (slide up or down) and other for reverse action if needed.

#### 3. Installation

#### 3.1. Standard installation procedure

- a. Download add-on archive file.
- b. Place archive into the root directory of your web site.
- c. Unpack archive at the site root directory.
- d. Make sure that admin and customer add-on skins appear at the active skin directory. You may need to move add-ons skins from default skin directory to the active skin directory.
- e. Login to the administration panel, go to the "Administration"  $\rightarrow$  "Add-ons" and click "Install" link next to the add-on name.


#### 3.2. Simplified installation procedure

- a. Download free "Addon Wizard" CS-Cart add-on and install it in a standard way.
- b. Install all other add-ons from "Addon Wizard" interface in a few mouse clicks.

## 4. Usage

- a. Go to the "Design" → "Blocks" at the administration panel
- b. Choose location and block you want to wrap into sliding wrapper
- c. Click "Block Options" on block (gear icon in bottom left corner of block)
- d. Select "Manual Sliding Wrapper" or "Automatic Sliding Wrapper". Wrapper settings appear below.
- e. Set up wrapper settings

Manual sliding wrapper has only one setting: "Collapsed by default". If setting checked wrapper will be collapsed when customer see it the first time. Next time customers open page with this block wrapper state will be read from Cookies. That means wrapper will be expanded or collapsed according to last state. If user expands it and reloads the page it remains expanded. If user collapses it and reloads the page it remains collapsed.



Automatic sliding wrapper has four settings:

- "Collapsed by default" for initial wrapper state (collapsed or expanded)
- "Hide Title" for not to display block title (if it displays customer may collapse or expand wrapper manually)
- "Action delay" for period of time in second from page fully loaded when action (slide up or down depending on initial state) will be performed.
- "Reverse action delay" for delay of second action. For example, you want block expands, and then collapsed back in some period. If setting has negative number reverse action is never performed.
